

This year, we disbursed a remarkable \$1,099,163 in grants, impacting the lives of 529 patients in the Greater New York Metro area, under care for a cancer diagnosis. In addition to aiding with daily living costs like rent, mortgage, and utilities, we arranged 2540 Uber rides to facilitate patients' transportation to and from their crucial oncology appointments, ensuring they access the necessary care.

The 4th Annual Raising Hope Gala surpassed expectations, raising over a million dollars! 

Our Mission & Who We Help

Our mission is to help relieve the financial stresses experienced by patients who are under care for a cancer diagnosis.

The New York Cancer Foundation is a 501(c)(3) organization which offers financial assistance grants for non-medical expenses to qualifying patients who are under care for a cancer diagnosis in the Greater Metro Area (Manhattan, Long Island, Staten Island, Queens, Brooklyn and the Bronx). The Foundation strives to relieve some of the financial burden patients face so they may focus on their treatment and healing.

Eligibility

To be eligible patients must meet the following criteria:

- Be living in the Greater Metro NY Area (Manhattan, Staten Island, Bronx, Queens, Brooklyn, Long Island)
- Be 18 years of age or older
- Have no more than \$12,500 total in liquid assets for patients and their household members combined
- Have an annual income at or below 400% of the national poverty level
- Be a U.S resident
- Have a diagnosis of cancer

Once approved, the New York Cancer Foundation may assist with day-to-day living expenses such as:

- Rent or Mortgage payments
- Utility payments (water, sewer, electric, etc)
- Telephone payments (landline or mobile)
- Car payments and insurance
- Life insurance
- Property Tax
- Grocery store gift cards

"What can I say as a NY Cancer Foundation Volunteer? Proud. It is my honor and privilege to be a part of something so meaningful and supportive of others. I can relate as a patient and a grant recipient in the past. My journey began in 2015 with Breast cancer at 44 years of age. During that time, I was struggling with a sick child, financial and emotional stressors.

The fear and pain I endured were lessened by the care I received. I literally had a family at NY Cancer from the front desk, lab techs, nurses, and doctors at every visit. The level of attention, compassion, and professionalism was life changing. Not only did they get me through that time, they inspired me to make hard life changes.

After many surgeries, infections, and chemotherapy I came to an abrupt halt in my life. The children and I lost our Medical insurance, and were struggling financially. At this time, I was introduced to the NY Cancer Foundation and staff. The Foundation was not only a lifeline, but the reason why I have joined as a Volunteer. The support I was provided propelled me into a mission to assist others in distress in my professional life as well. In 2019, I joined NY Cancer, spoke at three functions, volunteered at events and sent some of my client's there for assistance.

It is so simple to pay it forward. As I have said many times, "no one is immune to hardship and cancer." In the one life we have, to provide basic kindness, time and support will make an impact. I have instilled such beliefs and humility in my children. My daughter is a proud volunteer as well! I thoroughly support and hold a special place in my heart for the NY Cancer Foundation and NY Cancer and Blood Specialists."

"I'm a retired translator —English-Spanish-English. I'm divorced, no children, no siblings. All my relatives are in Argentina. New York City has been my beloved adoptive home for 49 years. But things changed when I was diagnosed with breast cancer in late 2020. And the long and frightening treatment with mastectomy followed, during the isolation of the pandemic. And the medical bills, so many, fell over my small budget —besides struggling with rent and basic expenses. All beyond the limited insurance.

I'm also a writer in English of novels and short stories. And yet I don't have enough words to express my gratitude to the New York Cancer Foundation for the generous support. Not only financially, which was so very needed, but also the kindness, the warmth of the ladies of the foundation, with whom I talked on the phone so many times. They made me feel I was not alone. Not enough words. Only a big Thank You from the deepest of my heart. What you do for those of us struggling with cancer and a limited budget is a blessing beyond description."
